We are currently at 449 members renewed- 88%

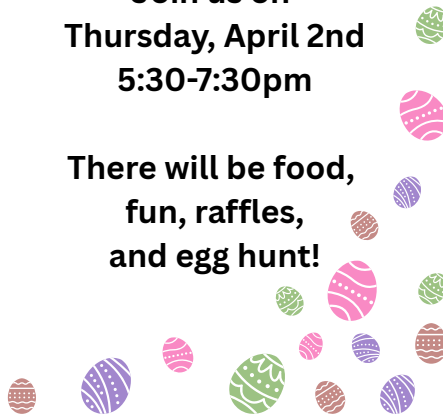

Chaplain Reflections - Norris Keirn

Mardi Gras means: "Fat Tuesday" or last chance to party before Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of seven weeks of fasting in preparation for the Easter vigil. Vigil means to keep awake or in this case mindful.

Lent then is a season where Christian pilgrims commemorate the 40 day/40 night fast of Jesus when he was tempted by Satan. In much of Christianity, this is adhered to by practicing various forms of fasting or self-denial.

Lent is observed by Orthodox, and roman Catholics, along with most "Mainline" Protestant churches. In the Roman church, meat is given up on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent, and fish is often substituted. For many Christians, a three-fold partial fast is observed where a special food or beverage is given up for this season, additional money is set aside for devotion or service.

The objective of fasting is to create a vacuum or space that God may fill in which the participant will draw closer. Often, we get so caught up in doing the routines of life that we forget or just get too busy to spend tie with our Creator. The Lenten season offers a special opportunity to renew or fortify our relationship with God. God honors all attempts that we try!

May you draw closer to God in this Lentil vigil.
